Coordinated Plan

The first regional [Transportation Coordination Committee \(TCC\)](#) meeting was held on March 10, 2021. Based on feedback from attendees, we will continue to work on creating a regional coordinated plan.

On March 16, 2021, [a public meeting](#) was held. This was advertised in all the local newspapers and through social media. A representative from the Northwest Signal attended the meeting leading to [this article](#).

Public Survey

Continue to share the [Transportation Needs Survey](#). We are currently at 35% of the goal for completed surveys.

Thank you to all the transportation providers that submitted their Provider Information Forms. The data is currently being organized in a draft of the Coordinated Plan.

Grant Opportunities

Rides to Community Immunity Program

ODOT's Rides to Community Immunity Program has allocated \$7 million to Ohio counties (based on Census numbers) to assist with transportation to vaccination locations. If a county does not have a public transportation system, the funds are being distributed to the Health Department. The funding allocations are as follows:

- Defiance: \$23,566
- Fulton: \$25,776
- Henry: \$17,033
- Williams: \$22,724

Mobility Manager 5310 Grant

The Mobility Manager funding application was released March 22, 2021 and due on April 30, 2021. The application process is for funding for the 2022 calendar year. Mobility Management is supported with funds from Federal Transit Administration (80%) and local match funds (20%). Northwest Ohio Mobility is seeking match fund donations for 2022 CY. Community Rides Grant

A [Program Request for Proposals](#) was sent out from the Rural Transportation Assistance Program (R-TAP). This grant is for innovation transportation program ideas specifically directed toward 5311 recipients. The Henry County Transportation Network (HCTN) is the only 5311 recipient in the region. The mobility manager and HCTN attended an informational webinar on the grant process and drafting a grant proposal.
